- you have pain in your mouth



- your gums are bleeding



- you have sores, lumps or any patches that are a different colour in your mouth



- If you are worried about your mouth for any reason.

## Which dentist can you see?

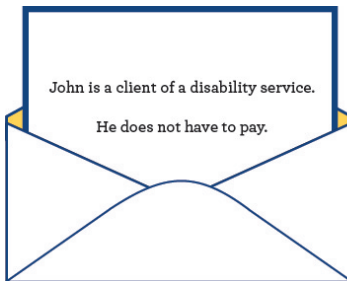


You can go to a public or private dentist.



You can go to a public dentist if you have a:

- healthcare card
- pension concession card.



If you are a client of a disability service, you will not have to pay at a public dentist.

You may need a letter from your disability service. This letter will tell the dentist that you are a client of the disability service.
